## Confirmation Name Form

The trend nowadays is to keep your baptismal name, living up to your own potential to become your own saint. Parents will remember that they were required to take a Confirmation name. This is no longer the case. If you choose to take a Confirmation name, it is to be a Christian name. It should reflect a saint whom you can admire and imitate. Don't just take a name for the sake of taking a Confirmation name. If you take a Confirmation name, this is the name your sponsor uses when he or she presents you to the Bishop for Confirmation.
